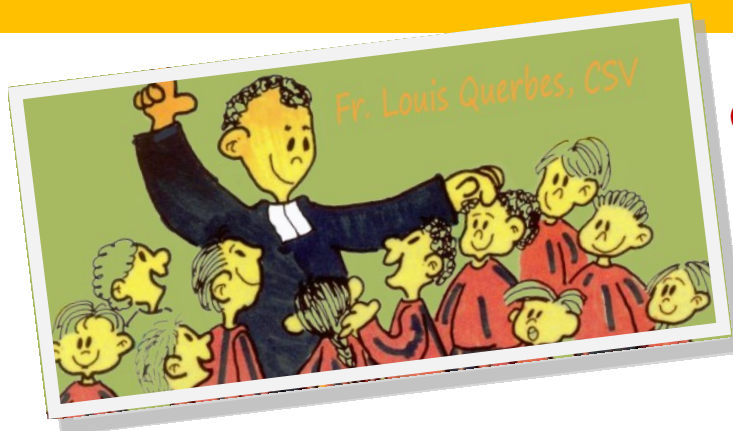

Our Vocation Crucifix

This is one of our class service projects.

The vocation crucifix is one way we will pray in a very special way for vocations to the religious life or priesthood. We believe that when families pray for future religious sisters, brothers and priests, God listens. More than that, God may plant a vocation seed in the very family doing the prayers.

It can also encourage questions and conversations concerning vocations. The process is very simple:

- Each week a different child's name will be drawn to receive the vocation crucifix and the special prayers for vocations.
- The child will take the class vocation crucifix into their home and commit to saying the provided special prayers. (This can be done at any time during the day, though many people find it especially meaningful when prayed together as a family before or after the evening meal.)
- The crucifix should be kept on the dining table or in a prominent place as a reminder of this special time of prayer.
- The following week, the child returns the crucifix to the catechist so the next child can be selected.

It will be a wonderful blessing to have a specific child and his or her family praying for vocations every week of the year!

A Family Prayer for Vocations

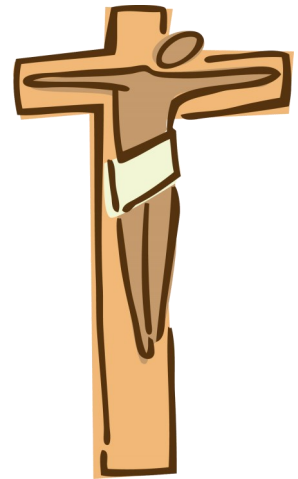
Loving Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
